



Minutes of ASA Eastern Territory meeting November 13, 2008.

Meeting opened at the conclusion of the General Assembly of the entire ASA body.

Brief Introductions and a General Roll Call ensued.

The minutes of the April 5th meeting in New Haven Ct. were passed around and approved.

A brief review of the 2008 JO and Adult tournaments occurred with reports from Stacey Stuck and Andy Dooley for their respective areas.

A review of the 2009 JO Tournaments occurred with the following:

The “A” division dates would be by code July 30, 31, and Aug. 1, 2. Locations same.

The 12/U would move to York August 6 – 9.

The 14/U would stay in Dayton July 30 – Aug 2.

The 16/U would move to Sterling Aug 6 – 9.

The 18/U would move to Sterling Aug 6 – 9.

A review of the 2009 Adult tournaments occurred next with the following changes:

Men’s Major and A Modified would now be posted as “open” (previously scheduled in Fairhaven, MA).

A question was raised in terms of where the Class E tournaments would be run this year.

A review of the umpire assignments for the Territory Tournaments occurred next:

Andy Dooley would like to get 4 umpires for each from the separate regions.

Bill and Ed presented a Board of Directors Update.

Guy DeMaio discussed the Territory Fund. Asked the body that each group must send in their dues to him.

Stacey Stuck discussed the JO program with input regarding the ACE program utilizing Register ASA.

The 2009 code and rule changes were discussed in terms of how (if any) the changes would affect us in the territory.

The 2009 Spring Meeting in Canton was discussed with Warren Jones extolling the virtues of how wonderful Canton Ohio is in the spring.

Nominations and Elections were held for Territory Vice President with Bill Cary receiving the only nomination and elected by unanimous decision.

General Discussion ensued revolving around the ACE program and “background” checks.

Motion was made and seconded adjourning the meeting.
